Please export your proposal to a PDF document to attach below.

Your project proposal should include the following as a minimum:

- A project name
- An explanation of the function or purpose of your project
- Your reason for choosing this as a project
- Clear communication

Other things you could also thinking about including are as follows (we do not expect you to include all of these as you're limited to one sheet of A3, but this list may help you consider what you want to include in your proposal):

- Does your project help solve or address a real-world problem?
- Will your project have a commercial use?
- Any research you have done on the thing your project is addressing
- What equipment will be required to design, build, or manufacture your project?
- What technical challenges and risks will there be?
- What costs would be associated with your project?
- Are there existing projects that are similar and, if so, how does yours stand out?
- What engineering principles will you use or learn as part of your proposal?
- How could you further develop on your designs?
- Will you be using the **Engineering Lifecycle**?
